BUDGET WORKSESSION

The motion to adopt the real estate tax rate of \$0.35 per \$100.00 was made by Mr. Crump and seconded by Mr. Jessie. All other rates remain the same. The motion carried by a vote of three (3) in favor (Crump, Jessie, Miller) to two (2) opposed (Williams, Crittenden).
