

**ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY
ASSESSING A FEE AS PART OF THE COSTS IN
EACH CRIMINAL OR TRAFFIC CASE FOR THE FUNDING OF COURTHOUSE
SECURITY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY,
VIRGINIA AS FOLLOWS:

The “Ordinance of the County of Middlesex Assessing a Fee as Part of the Costs in Each Criminal or Traffic Case for the Funding of Courthouse Security” is repealed as of June 30, 2007 and replaced with this ordinance.

There is hereby assessed a fee of \$10.00 as part of the costs in each criminal or traffic case in the General District and Circuit Courts in which a defendant is convicted for a violation of any statute or ordinance.

The assessment imposed by this ordinance shall be collected by the Clerk of the Court in which the case is heard, remitted to the Treasurer of Middlesex County and held by such Treasurer subject to appropriation by the Board of Supervisors of Middlesex County to the Sheriff’s Office for the funding of courthouse security.

This ordinance shall be effective July 1, 2007.
