#### **Minutes**

The Board considered the minutes of the June 13, 2023, meeting. The motion to approve the minutes was made by Mrs. Sanders and seconded by Mr. Armstead and carried with a 5-0 vote.

**Public Hearings**

**A. Wetlands Application # 2023-1093** submitted by Eugene Kendall Jr. This request is to add 40' extension of Class A-1 Rip Rap on the Northside of waterfront peninsula to address bank erosion within the Wetlands Board's jurisdiction. The proposed project is located on Cores Creek, at Tax Map Parcel # 40-56-3B. 1220 Providence Rd

Eugene Kendall, Jr. was present to represent the application and to explain the proposed project.

Chairman Dolezal opened the hearing for comments from the public.

There being no additional comments, the public portion of the hearing was closed.

Chairman Dolezal began a brief period of questions and comments between the Board and the agent.

Mr. Armstead questioned the placement of stone at the opening of the creek that was permitted in the past, owner was aware, but stone had not been placed. Mr. Boyd questioned the difference in the number on the drawing and the advertisement, was addressed in staff report, and would need to be a condition of the approval. Mrs. Sanders had no comments. Mr. Schafer stated the project looked good. Mr. Woodward noted that the change in the drawing would be good to address any issues with changes. Chairman Dolezal noted no loss of grasses – yes – fix any damage – yes – RPA Permit – yes per Mr. Longest – access – upland per owner, and no loss of vegetation – per owner yes.

There being no further questions or comments from the Board, Chairman Dolezal asked for disposition of the application.

The motion to approve the application as submitted was made by Mr. Boyd and seconded by Mrs. Sanders and carried with a 5-0 Vote with an 3 Year time limit with the following conditions:
