Public Comments:

- Up to one business day prior to the meeting, public comments can be emailed to: bmuncy@co.middlesex.va.us, mailed to the Middlesex County Administrator's Office, PO Box 428, Saluda, VA 23149 or delivered to the Woodward Building Drop Box (County Administration Building) at 877 General Puller Highway. During the meeting, public comments will be addressed by the Chairman or his designee and read into the record.
- If you have a microphone on your computer, you can present comments through your computer. There is a raise-hand feature on the Zoom meeting page that allows you to raise your hand to make public comment. The moderator or Chairman can see your hand raised and the microphone will be unmuted so that you can make comments. **If you do not have a microphone and wish to make comments, you would have to call into the meeting using the information above.**
- If you call in by phone to comment, you can press *9, which will be the same as the raise-hand feature. When the Chairman calls on you, your phone will be unmuted, and you can make your comments.
- You must identify yourself and time limits are still in place (3 minutes per person)
