

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
 APPORTIONMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE MIDDLESEX
 COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, ESTABLISHING
 BOUNDARY LINES OF THE ELECTION DISTRICTS,
 NAMING EACH ELECTION DISTRICT, AND REPEALING
 THE PRIOR ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Middlesex County Board of Supervisors:

Section 1: Pursuant to authority contained in Sections 24.2-304.1 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the election districts of Middlesex County, Virginia are hereby created and established as set forth in this Ordinance.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall become effective May 11, 2011

Section 3: The Election Districts with populations set forth are as follows:

Section 4: For the purposes of this ordinance, there shall be lines drawn to designate election districts. The boundaries of the respective election districts shall be set forth below:

JAMAICA ELECTION DISTRICT

The Jamaica Election District shall be defined by the area made by connecting lines made at the following boundaries:

Western Boundary: The boundary with Essex County from the Northern Boundary of the Jamaica Election District to the Southern Boundary of the Jamaica Election District.

Northern Boundary: The centerline of LaGrange Creek from the Eastern Boundary of the Jamaica Election District along the centerline of the Rappahannock River to the Western Boundary of the Jamaica Election District.

Southern Boundary: The border with King and Queen County and Gloucester County from the Western Boundary of the Jamaica Election District to the Eastern Boundary of the Jamaica Election District.

Eastern Boundary: Beginning at a point of intersection with the centerline of LaGrange Creek and Private Road LaGrange Lane; thence South along the centerline of LaGrange Lane to its intersection with Private Road Sun Beau Circle - a distance of 0.2 mile; thence South along the centerline of Private Road Sun Beau Circle to its intersection with Private Road Racetrack Road - a distance of 0.38 mile; thence in a northerly direction along the centerline of Private Road Racetrack Road to its intersection with Private Road Sunderland Creek Road - a distance of 0.7 mile; thence South along the centerline of Private Road Sunderland Creek Road to its intersection with State Route 676 - a distance of 0.51 mile; thence in a southwesterly direction along the centerline of State Route 676 to the intersection with State Route 602 - a distance of 0.87 mile; thence in a southeasterly direction along the centerline of State Route 602 to its intersection with State Route 1011 - a distance of 2.14 miles; thence South along the centerline of State Route 1011 to the intersection with an unnamed road - a distance of 0.67 mile; thence in an easterly direction along the centerline of the unnamed road to its intersection with an unnamed road - a distance of 0.11 mile; thence in a northwesterly direction along the centerline of the unnamed road to its intersection with an unnamed road - a distance of 0.05 mile; thence South along the centerline of the unnamed road to its intersection with the centerline of Urbanna Creek; thence west along the centerline of Urbanna Creek to its intersection with the Centerline of Glebe Swamp; thence West along the centerline of Glebe Swamp to its intersection with State Route 616; thence in a southwesterly direction along the centerline of State Route 616 to its intersection with U.S Route 17 - a distance of 1.16 miles; thence in a southeasterly direction along the centerline of U.S. Route 17 right-of-way to its intersection with State Route 665; thence in a southerly direction along the centerline of State Route 665 to its intersection with the centerline of an unnamed tributary of Dragon Swamp; thence South along the centerline of said tributary to its intersection with the boundary of Gloucester County;

SALUDA ELECTION DISTRICT

The Saluda Election District shall be defined by the area made by connecting lines made at the following boundaries:

Western Boundary: The Western Boundary shall be the same as that described as being the Eastern Boundary of the Jamaica Election District.

Northern Boundary: The Centerline of LaGrange Creek from the Western Boundary of the Saluda District along the Centerline of the Rappahannock River to the Eastern Boundary of the Saluda Election District.

Southern Boundary: The border with Gloucester County from the Western Boundary of the Saluda District to the Eastern Boundary of the Saluda District.

Eastern Boundary: Beginning at a point of intersection with the centerline of the Rappahannock River and State Route, 713 Hibble Road; thence Southwest along the centerline of State Route 713 Hibble Road to its intersection with Private Road Sea Horse Lane - a distance of 0.56 mile; thence South along the centerline of Private Road Sea Horse Lane to its intersection with Private Road Christchurch Lane - a distance of 0.13 mile; thence in a southerly direction along the centerline of Christchurch Lane to the intersection with State Route 638 Christchurch Drive - a distance of 0.03 mile; thence in a Easterly direction along the centerline of State Route 638 Christchurch Drive to its intersection with State Route 33 - a distance of .12 miles; thence in a Southwesterly direction along the centerline of State Route 33 to its intersection with State Route 641 - a distance of 1.08 miles; thence in a Southerly direction along the centerline of State Route 641 to its intersection with State Route 629 - a distance of .46 miles; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the centerline of State Route 629 to its intersection with State Route 644 - a distance of .93 miles; thence in a Southerly direction along the centerline of State Route 644 to its intersection with Unnamed Private Road - a distance of 1 miles; thence in a Southerly direction along the centerline of Unnamed Road to its intersection with the Gloucester County boundary line.

HARMONY VILLAGE ELECTION DISTRICT

The Harmony Village Election District shall be defined by the area made by connecting lines made at the following boundaries:

Western Boundary: The Western Boundary shall be the same as that described as being the Eastern Boundary of the Saluda Election District.

Northern Boundary: From the centerline of Locklies Creek from the Western Boundary along the centerline of the Rappahannock River to the Eastern Boundary of the Harmony Village District.

Southern Boundary: The line shared with Gloucester County and Mathews County from the Western Boundary of the Harmony Village Election District to the Eastern Boundary of the Harmony Village Election District.

Eastern Boundary: Beginning at a point of intersection with the centerline of Locklies Creek and State Route 661; thence Southerly along the centerline of State Route 661 to its intersection with State Route 623 - a distance of 0.1 mile; thence Southwesterly along the centerline of State Route 623 to its intersection with State Route 625 - a distance of 1.5 mile; thence in a Westerly direction

along the centerline of State Route 625 to its intersection with State Route 33 - a distance of 1.38 mile; thence Southeasterly along the centerline of State Route 33 to its intersection with State Route 707 - a distance of 0.47 mile; thence Southeasterly along the centerline of State Route 707 to its intersection with State Route 629 - a distance of 0.28 mile; thence Westerly along the centerline of State Route 629 to its intersection with the centerline of the Healy's Mill Pond spillway - a distance of 0.19 mile; thence southerly down an unnamed creek into the Piankatank River and intersecting with the boundary of Gloucester County.

HARTFIELD ELECTION DISTRICT

The Hartfield Election District shall be defined by the area made by connecting lines made at the following boundaries:

Western Boundary: The Western Boundary shall be the same as that described as being the Eastern Boundary of the Harmony Village Election District.

Northern Boundary: The centerline of Locklies Creek from the Western Boundary of the Hartfield Election District along the centerline of the Rappahannock River to the Eastern Boundary of the Hartfield Election District.

Southern Boundary: The line shared with Gloucester County and Mathews County from the Western Boundary of the Hartfield Election District to the Eastern Boundary of the Hartfield Election District.

Eastern Boundary: Beginning at a point of intersection of the centerline of The Rappahannock River and Unnamed Private Road; thence Southwesterly along the centerline of Unnamed Private Road to its intersection with State Route 702 - a distance of 0.61 mile; thence Westerly along the centerline of State Route 702 to its intersection with State Route 628 - a distance of .86 mile; thence in a Southerly direction along the centerline of State Route 628 to its intersection with State Route 33 - a distance of 1.42 mile; thence Northeasterly along the centerline of State Route 33 to its intersection with State Route 1040 - a distance of 0.4 mile; thence Southerly along the centerline of State Route 1040 to its intersection with Unnamed private Road - a distance of 1.11 mile, at the "End of State Maintenance"; thence Easterly along the centerline of Unnamed Private Road to its intersection with the centerline of Healy Creek - a distance of 0.11 mile.

PINETOP ELECTION DISTRICT

The Pinetop Election District shall be defined by the area made by connecting lines made at the following boundaries:

Western Boundary: The Western Boundary shall be the same as that described as being the Eastern Boundary of the Hartfield Election District.

Northern Boundary: The Rappahannock River from the Western Boundary of the Pinetop Election District to the Chesapeake Bay

Southern Boundary: The Gloucester County and Mathews County lines from the Western Boundary of the Pinetop Election District to the Chesapeake Bay.

Eastern Boundary: The Chesapeake Bay

Section 5: One (1) supervisor shall be elected from each of the election districts as created by this Ordinance.

Section 6: Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

Adopted on May 10, 2011 following a duly advertised public hearing, on a motion by Mr. Jessie seconded by Mr. Revere and carried.
