ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids in the purpose of establishing the purchase price for the Vertical Booster Pumps Skid and Control Systems associated with the Eastern Middlesex County Regional Water System Phase 1A and 3B equipment supply bids will be received by Middlesex Water Authority at their office (877 General Puller Hwy, Saluda, VA 23149) until **2:00 PM** local time on **July 23, 2020**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud. The bids shall represent the cost for supply, delivery, and training of the materials as described in the Technical Specifications for the Vertical Booster Pump Skid and Control System. The Equipment Suppliers shall guarantee its supply and delivery of the Vertical Booster Pump Skid and Control System equipment to the applicable Construction Contractor at the price indicated on the Bid Form. Such price shall remain valid up to 18 months (until approximately February 2022) from the date the equipment purchase contract is executed. The executed equipment purchase contract will be assigned to the applicable Construction Contractor. Equipment Suppliers shall be responsible for delivery of this equipment to the location designated by the applicable Construction Contractor, and is responsible for operator training.

Bids shall be on a lump sum basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

Bidding Material Suppliers shall be aware of the following requirement: Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A – Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference, applies an American Iron and Steel requirement to this project. All iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States. The term “iron and steel products” means the following products made primarily of iron and steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal casting, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials. The deminimis and minor components waiver apply to this contract.

Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office. Bidding Documents are also available for download from an online site free of charge by contacting the Issuing Office. Alternatively, printed Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office either through in-person pick-up or via mail. Printed Bidding Documents will be sent at the prospective Bidder’s delivery method of choice and at their expense; the shipping charge will depend on the shipping method chosen. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder’s date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office. Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
